Angkor Hospital for Children is one of the best hospitals that provide free health services to the children.

The physiotherapy project in Angkor Hospital for Children has been running since 1st of August 2007 up to now.

I've been work since 17th of November 2008 up to now , I just finished physiotherapy school in Phnom penh , during I stat the work I have Katrin , Rany, Andrea (she left) they are give good adviser for me and she showed me a lot of methods for treatment especially with the babies .some of methods are different of the Cambodia methods . I will try all off my best to lend the new methods. On the 5st to 17th January Rany she has been to Phnom Phen for last practicum

There are four Physiotherapists in the hospital in this month. So, we can treat all the patients that need physiotherapy.

During this month, many children came to the AHC to get the health services and, Physiotherapy was also provided to them.

Monthly Activities:

- Usually we treat the patients depending on the diseases and the doctor's order.
- We treated the patients in all wards in AHC when needed. Most common diseases seen are respiratory /cardiopulmonary diseases like Severe Pneumonia, Asthma, and Bronco-pneumonia.
- During this month there are some children from OPD needed to do physiotherapy. We advised and showed the parents how to do exercises at home with their children.
- Most of the Tuesday I joined the lunch talk to get information from the nurses or volunteer
- We also went to Home Care Visit to see Cerebral Palsy patient at home and gave the exercises and advise to the parents.



The result of Treatments:

- Not so different from last month,
- The majority of the cases are babies and small children; we do the breathing therapy on the lap if it is possible and, breathing exercises with the bigger children. We also try to advise the parents about the treatment of their children.
